## **Listening Focus**

Listen for the interplay of five performers: Bb clarinet, violin, cello and piano, with one additional performer who covers piccolo/flute/amplified alto flute. The melody is reminiscent of Middle-Eastern modal music, but with chromatic saturation. Also note the extremely virtuosic passages required of the performers.

#### Form at a Glance

Asymmetrical arch form, loosely structured, with texturally dense central section

## **Timed Listening Guide**

- 0:00 thin texture begins the arch with "A" material performed by solo amplified alto flute; soloist moves freely against static accompaniment in clarinet, violin and cello
- 0:59 clarinet moves in counterpoint with flute; violin and cello sustain accompaniment
- 2:08 piano enters, then other voices join as texture thickens and rhythm intensifies; listen for special effects created by flutter tonguing on winds, string glissandi, and piano pedaling; peak of the arch reached in this extended section
- 5:52 march-like piano accompanies various combinations of unison pairs and heterophonic passages
- 7:41 unison passage involving all voices marks move toward thinner texture
- 8:12 slower tempo, thinner texture
- 9:32 return of "A" material featuring solo flute; thinning to nothing
